Dear Parent/Guardian:

N.J. State Mandates are as follows:

All new/transfer students must have a physical exam no more than 365 days prior to school entry.

All students entering Pre-K-3, Pre-K-4, Kindergarten, 3rd and 6th grades should have a physical exam no more than 365 days prior to school entry.

Immunization records must be up to date and presented to the school prior to school entry. All Pre-K students must have current Flu Vaccine and documentation of Lead screening.

If it is necessary for your child to receive any medication during school hours, school health policy requires that you provide a written request for the administration of the prescribed medication. Your private physician must also provide written orders detailing the diagnosis or type of illness being treated, the name of the medication, dosage, administration route, time of administration and length of treatment. This includes any medications that a student will self-administer due to asthma or other potentially life-threatening illness. Medications should be in the original pharmacy labeled container which will remain in school.

The school nurse or parent/guardian is the only one permitted to administer medication in the school and/or on school trips. In the event that the school nurse is not present, the parent can give written authorization for the delegate to administer the medication. The nurse will review in advance the administration procedure with the delegate.

Medication forms are available in the nurse's office.
