

- 7. Questions & Announcements will be addressed to Ms. Verdonck:
- a. Class photos Parents were wondering if a date has been set and some do not mind the idea of wearing a mask for at least the group picture as a matter of historical context and safety.
- b. Does the school share in any revenue generated from the photography contract? If not, we might be missing an opportunity to generate some revenue for the school or parents guild. Some parents felt it seems like a worthwhile conversation with the photography studio and perhaps we can bake this into the contract.
- c. Parents were wondering about the Halloween Truck or Treat- hypothetically, if contraction rates remain as low as they currently stand and/or do not increase from their current standing, would we be able to host a Trunk or Treat at the school as we have done in the past 8 or so years? If not, what about a scarecrow fundraising effort?
- d. The 4th grade alleges audio/ connectivity issues affecting their remote learning experience. If this continues unresolved over the next week, would this be an acceptable reason to allow those children (or other classes facing such an issue) to opt back into school in this first phase.
